**Divisions:** Intro Novice Horse .

Intro Novice Rider

Junior—21 Years of age and under.

Adult Amateur—Those over 21 who are not paid to ride, train, or teach.

Open—Open to all riders

**Awards:** First place award and ribbons through sixth place. Champion and Reserve ribbons for Introductory Level, Training level--Jr, Adult Amateur, and Open; any higher level with 3 or more entries.

**Scores:** Riders are responsible for checking the accuracy of their scores. Corrections should be brought to the show manager's attention. No changes will be made after the end of the show.

**Attire:** Riding boots, breeches, helmet and collared shirt, tucked in. Half chaps allowed. Helmet and boots required at all times when mounted. Regulation helmets with harnesses secured suggested to all but required for all riders 18 or younger. Coats/braiding optional. Driving attire informal or marathon—presentation not scored. Aprons optional.

**STRIDE Dressage Medal** is a ridden test judged only on the rider's position, effectiveness of aids and ability to control the horse/pony (i.e. equitation). Riders will execute the highest test of the level entered and must enter the same level or one level below their current level ridden in regular dressage tests. For example a rider showing in First 1 and 2 at a show may enter the Dressage Medal class showing either First 4 or Training 4. All entries compete against each other for placement (Training, First, etc.). Entry fee \$15..

**Footing and Rings:** Ring for Driven Dressage will be 40 m by 80 m sand/clay. Ridden dressage will be on sand/clay with ample warm-up. One 20 x 40 m riding ring may be on sand/clay for Intro and Training Level.
